Nevada State Fire Fighters Association Fund Raising Activities

The Nevada State Firefighters Association is currently conducting fund raising efforts throughout Nevada. Established in 1935, the Nevada State Firefighters Association (NSFA) is a non-profit organization serving over 1400 firefighters from across the state. Most of its members are volunteers with others coming from the ranks of paid military, industrial and professional firefighters, as well as state and local safety professionals.

Here is how the NSFA fund-raising campaign is being conducted: The NSFA Fund-raising Center is contacting residents of Nevada via telephone for the purpose of soliciting funds through donation. (Callers are hired by NSFA on an hourly basis and do not receive commissions.) The funds raised through the NSFA will be used state wide for a variety of services:

- The Burn Fund Program that provides benefits for the victims of fires
- Annual Training Conferences for volunteer and (well as) paid firefighters
- Benevolence Fund that provides benefits for those firefighters killed or injured in the line of duty
- Scholarship Programs for the families of firefighters
