Dry Christmas trees remain one of most dangerous elements during the holiday season. As has been the case for a number of years, CCFD will put a match to a dry tree to demonstrate how quickly it ignites and spreads.

“You’ve waited all year

Well, actually, we’ll have six trees: four that have been kept in water and two that haven’t. We’ll stand them next to one another and put a spark to the dry ones. In a few moments only the four kept in water will still be recognizable. Naturally, we’ll have a fire engine from the department on hand as a precaution.
