

**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:**

This is to advise you that the 2005 Clark County Ordinance, 1102.6, Residential Barbecues, states the following:

**“Outdoor cooking at apartment, condominium and other residential occupancies with portable barbecuing equipment is prohibited within 10 feet of any building wall, overhang, balcony or opening.**

- Exceptions:**
- 1. Electric Barbecues.**
  - 2. Group R, Division 3 Occupancies.**

**The storage of LPG fueled barbecues and equipment is prohibited within living quarters.”**

This Department recommends the following safe guards for outdoor cooking safety at your complex by providing water for extinguishments (garden hose) in the event of a fire or a spill of hot coals and using a metal container specifically for the disposal of the used coals.

It is the responsibility of the property owner/manager and/or association to notify all tenants of this requirement. A copy of this letter signed by each tenant must be kept on file **at the complex** for Fire Department review.
